


IDPs supported after fleeing home due to violence.

In 2025, our community in Mirebalais fled gang violence to find temporary shelter in an in-between encampment. After nine months there, they moved to a more adequate and permanent residence.

The time in the encampment was challenging, but God was faithful. We are hearing some key themes emerging from the encampment period:

“God sees your suffering”
“Hope in the midst of trials”
“Jesus, light in the darkness”




We met in person four times in 2025. It was a joy to connect, share stories of how God is moving in Haiti, and encourage each other!

50+ people logged on to join one of our live video calls. One of our favorite moments from our Connect Calls was when the kids performed a Christmas dance from the new facility!



Our farm team has continued operating the farm, bringing fresh and nutrient-dense produce to the kids in our new location. Distributions have included staples such as cornmeal, sweet potatoes, rice, beans, tomatoes, okra, pumpkins, corn, and limes, along with seasonal fruits.



111 children and at-risk youth currently reside in GVCM's Children's Home.



Our clinic staff has continued to see as many patients as possible. **They have returned to Mirebalais for brief periods to reopen the clinic and provide care, while also operating pop-up clinics in northern Haiti, particularly treating children.** Even when clinic operations were disrupted, our staff used their time and skills to help community members. In 2026, we expect the clinic in Mirebalais to partially re-open, the staff splitting their time between there and our new location.
